

## INVITATION FOR BIDS

The **Indiana County Commissioners** will receive sealed bids for the **Airport Farmhouse Masonry Repair Project** until **11:00 a.m. on May 6, 2026** at the Commissioners Hearing Room, Second Floor Courthouse, 825 Philadelphia St., Indiana, PA 15701 at which time and place bids will be opened and recorded.

The project consists of masonry repair work at the airport farmhouse located at **398 Airport Road, Indiana, PA 15701**, including but not limited to grinding mortar joints, repointing, and related work.

A \$10.00 fee for postage and handling will be required for Contract Documents that are mailed to bidders. All checks shall be made payable to the County of Indiana. There will be no charge for electronic copies.

The work on this project will be performed under the provisions of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Labor and Industry, Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act as set forth in the Contract Documents.

Each bid must be accompanied by cash, bid bond, cashier's check, or certified check in the amount of 10% of the bid and submitted in a sealed envelope marked Airport Farmhouse Masonry Repair Project. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days after bid opening.

The Indiana County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. **AWARD CRITERIA AND BASIS FOR REJECTION** will be in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders of the contract and technical documents.
