## 1. Obtain the Application for Veteran Discount ID Card:

## 2. Take completed application along with a copy of your DD-214 (Certificate of Discharge) to the Recorder of Deeds Office, 1st Floor – Courthouse

- -If you do not have a copy of your DD-214 (Certificate of Discharge), please call the Indiana County Department of Veterans Affairs at (724) 465-3815 for assistance.
