### Veteran Spotlight

This month's Veteran is Amelia Nelson.

Amelia is the new secretary for our Veterans Affairs Department. She is originally from the Chicago area where she enlisted in the Army in August 2001 as a 63G, fuel and electrical mechanic which eventually merged to a 91B, wheeled vehicle mechanic.

# Claims predators want to prey on your benefits

Have you noticed advertisements from companies offering to help with the VA claims and appeals process? Do their services seem too good to be true, leaving you wondering whether to trust them? If so, you are not alone.

More Veterans are getting VA health care and benefits than ever before, which also presents opportunities for scammers to commit fraud against Veterans and their families. These increased benefits have led to a rise in shady companies and individuals that are not accredited by VA, offering claims assistance services and charging hefty fees when they do.



### Prepare for VA's Secure story How to report a **√** Sign-in changes

VA is committed to making it as easy as possible for Veterans to manage their benefits and health care online while protecting their identities and data. As part of this commitment, and in an effort to streamline Veterans' sign-in options, VA will transition to two modern, secure, sign-in options in 2025: a Login.gov or ID.me account.



### Veteran's death to VA

After a Veteran passes away, family members should report the death of the Veteran to VA as soon as possible to stop current benefits payments. If the death is not reported promptly, survivors or executors of the Veteran's estate may to have repay any overpayments received.



### DMVA Provides Financial Assistance for Higher Education to Eligible Children of Veterans

With the start of another school year around the corner, the Pennsylvania Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) is providing financial assistance eligible to children of veterans for hiaher education. The DMVA's Educational Gratuity Program provides assistance financial children οf honorably discharged veterans who have service-connected disabilities and served during periods of war or armed conflict, or children of veterans who died in service during a period of war or armed conflict.

### **Requesting Military Records**

The National Archives maintains military service records of veterans who have been discharged from the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Department of the Air Force and Coast Guard.

Through the National Archives site, veterans can request a copy of their Defense Department Form 214 called the "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty," Official Military Personnel File, replacement medals and medical and health records.
